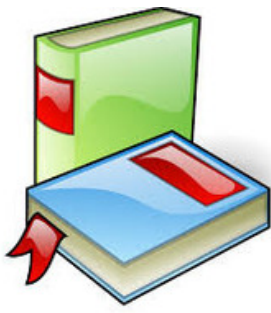


NJ SCHOOL LIBRARIES & ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS
